

DRESS CODE - HIGH SCHOOL DRESS CODE (9TH GRADE – 12TH GRADE)**YOUNG MEN AND YOUNG LADIES' DRESS CODE****Daily Attire – Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday:**

Business jackets/blazers are worn all day, every day - Black, Brown, Forest Green, Navy, Gray or Burgundy
Dress Pants (Young Men and Young Ladies) or Skirt (Young Ladies) - Navy, Black, Burgundy, Forest Green, Brown or Gray
Oxford (button-down) Shirt - White, Sky Blue, Blue, Navy, Black, Brown, Gray, Forest Green, Gold or Purple
Shoes – Any Dark Brown, Navy, Black or Charcoal leather shoe is acceptable

We do not wear leggings/jeggings, capris, cargo, joggers or ankle pants. Sweaters DO NOT replace a Business Jacket but may be worn underneath.

Dress Attire - Wednesday:

Oxford-style Shirt - White
Business Skirt or Trousers (Young Ladies)/Dress Pants (Young Men) – Black
Business Jacket – Black
Neck Tie (Young Men)
Dress shoes - Black
*All skirts must cover the knees and side-splits must not expose the thigh.
*Heels should not exceed 2.5 inches.

Outerwear: No hooded or zippered attire should be worn in the building.

Shirt Tails: Must be tucked in at all times. Administration or designee reserves the right to decide if a shirt can be worn “out”.

***Young women can wear business/professional earrings and will remove ALL other piercings (facial, nose, tongue etc.) and cover tattoos via clothes, make-up, band-aids, bandages, etc. Young men will remove ALL piercings and cover tattoos via band-aids, bandages, etc.**

Additional Daily Attire Requirements for ALL Students

- We wear navy, black or brown belts.
- We wear the appropriate size pants at or above our waistlines.
- We wear hats outside the building only.
- We wear the appropriate size business attire so that it fits as designed.
- We wear **solid colored socks** (*neon or brightly colored socks are not professional attire and will not be worn*).

ALL CLOTHING MUST BE SOLID IN COLOR INCLUDING SOCKS, BELTS, SHOES, etc.

PLEASE NOTE: Our dress code will be strictly enforced. The following actions will be taken when students are not dressed appropriately:

1. Parents will be notified and required to bring appropriate school attire to comply with the dress code.
2. Administrative Intervention.
3. Student will be sent home.

IN ALL CASES WHERE IT IS NOT SPECIFICALLY SPELLED OUT, ADMINISTRATION WILL HAVE FINAL AUTHORITY IN WHAT IS DEEMED APPROPRIATE DRESS.
