

DRESS CODE - MIDDLE SCHOOL (6TH GRADE – 8TH GRADE)

YOUNG LADIES' UNIFORM DRESS CODE

Daily Uniform - Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday:

Pants, shorts, Khaki jumper, skirt - Khaki, Navy Blue, or Black
Polo or Oxford-style shirt – short/long sleeves - Solid White, Purple, Gold or Light Blue
Tennis Shoe – Solid color – White or Black

***Cargo pants, skinny-styled pants, leggings/jeggings, joggers and jean material are NOT permitted.**

*Shorts and skirts must cover the knee.

Dress Uniform (Wednesday ONLY):

Skirt or pants – Black

Collared button-down blouse or Oxford-style shirt (buttoned down from top to bottom) – White

Dress Shoes – Black, Navy or Dark Brown (For your safety, heels of shoes should not exceed 2")

*Splits and skirt hemline must cover the knee

YOUNG MEN'S UNIFORM DRESS CODE

Daily Uniform - Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday:

Pants or shorts - Khaki, Navy Blue or Black

Polo or Oxford-style shirt - Solid White, Purple, Gold or Light Blue

Tennis Shoe – Solid color – White or Black

***Cargo pants, skinny-styled pants, leggings/jeggings, joggers and jean material are NOT permitted.**

Dress Uniform (Wednesday ONLY):

Dress pants – Black

Collared button-down or Oxford style dress shirt – White

Neck Tie

Dress Shoes – Black, Navy or Dark Brown

Additional Uniform Requirements for Young Ladies and Young Men

*Hooded or zippered attire, hats, scarves, very large bows, hair ties, and head wraps are worn outside only and should be removed upon entering the building.

*Shirt tails should be tucked in at all times.

*Young men will not wear earrings.

*We wear solid black or brown belts.

*We wear solid colored socks. Neon or bright colored socks are not appropriate.

*We wear the appropriate size pants at or above our waistlines.

*We wear solid stockings - black, white, nude or navy.

The Uniform Policy will be STRICTLY enforced.

The following actions will be taken when a student is not dressed appropriately:

- 1.) Parent will be notified and required to bring the appropriate school attire to comply with dress code.
- 2.) Administrative intervention.
